

Intercampus study between Monash Clayton and Sunway campuses

Engineering students who are studying in the field of chemical engineering, electrical and computer systems engineering, mechanical engineering or mechatronics engineering or one of the associated double degrees at either Clayton or Sunway campus can apply to spend one or two semesters studying in the same program at the other campus. Students applying for intercampus study, who are not exchange or transfer students, need only to have completed 48 credit points in their studies, have an honours weighted average (HWA) of 60% and maintain a full-time study load per semester. Clayton students approved for intercampus study in a discipline at Sunway who could not be admitted to that discipline at Clayton due to quota restrictions, are not considered to be admitted to that field of study at Clayton or elsewhere.

Other than students studying the above fields of engineering at the Clayton and Sunway campuses, all engineering students must complete 96 credit points of study in order to be eligible for study abroad, exchange programs and intercampus study at other international campuses.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

Purpose and Rationale

The Faculty of Engineering, Clayton campus and the School of Engineering, Sunway campus both offer engineering degree programs in the fields of chemical, electrical and computer systems, mechanical and mechatronics engineering. Students on both campuses undertaking the Bachelor of Engineering in the above mentioned fields or the Bachelor of Mechatronics Engineering, and any of the associated double degrees, are therefore undertaking the same engineering course material.

As the material presented on both campuses is the same, students applying to study on the other campus are regarded as undertaking intercampus study, rather than exchange or transfer. The faculty therefore only requires students to complete 48 credit points, rather than the 96 credit points of study generally required by students when studying abroad, participating in exchange programs or intercampus study at other international campuses.

Scope:

The policy refers to all students enrolled in an engineering degree at either Clayton campus or Sunway campus in the field of chemical engineering, electrical and computer systems engineering, mechanical engineering or mechatronics engineering or one of the associated double degrees at either Clayton or Sunway campuses..
